



## 2018-2019 Income Guidelines for Lesson and Class Rates

In accordance with our mission Hopewell Music Cooperative North is committed to providing high-quality, accessible music lessons for the Northside community. We base our fees on a sliding scale ranging from standard pay (\$20/30min) to free lessons.

*Our lessons rates are based on income before taxes and the federal lunch guidelines for school-aged students.*

A student may also receive free lessons if they fall under one or more of these categories:

1. A student is on MFIP, SNAP, FDPIR, RCCI
2. In foster care
3. In transitional housing

***Families with school aged children receiving free and reduced lessons MUST provide a copy of their federal lunch letter to Hopewell Music Cooperative North as a part of the registration process to begin lessons. Copies can be made at the Hopewell Office at no cost. Lesson rate status will be reviewed at the beginning of each school year.***
